Ehret Family Winery is the creation of the husband and wife, Pierre Ehret and Susan Robertson. The Sonoma County Winery sources all of its grapes from the family owned estate of Bavarian Lion Vineyards located in the esteemed Knight's Valley AVA, just North of Napa Valley in Sonoma County, where hand crafted small lots of cabernet sauvignon, cabernet franc, merlot and syrah are harvested to create savory wines. It is the Ehrets' philosophy that wine making starts in the vineyard.

Pierre Ehret is the owner of Sonoma County's renowned Flamingo Resort Hotel & Conference Center in Santa Rosa, California. In 1996 Pierre established the Bavarian Lion Vineyard in Knights



Valley, selling the high quality fruit to the premier wineries in Sonoma County. His upbringing in Germany with business interest on both sides of the Atlantic developed an appreciation and understanding of fine wines, both domestic and European. This experience coupled with running Bavarian Lion Vineyard for the last decade prompted him to establish Ehret Family Winery as a family business.
